**PARKING GARAGE CHANGES:** Please be aware of the changes to the Ann Street Parking Garage located directly behind the church.

- Parking is free on weekends and after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. This remains the same as always.
- Parking in the garage during weekday business hours, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., cost \$1/hour with a maximum of 5 hours. This remains the same as always.
- In addition to the \$1/hour fee, there is a 35 cent surcharge. Maximum cost per day if staying 5+ hours would be \$5.35. The surcharge is new.
- To park in the garage during business hours, you must do one of the following two things:
  1. Download the ParkMobile app to your smart phone and pay via the app. We are zone 1610.
  2. If you do not have a smart phone, you should call 877.727.5014 for payment instructions. These methods of payment are new.
